HELPFUL STUFF!

Enclosed you will find some helpful documents. Please note that while our school days follow the Broward County Public School Calendar, if your child is enrolled in the MOST program for aftercare, there are some non-school days that we will remain open for childcare. Both calendars are provided here along with the September breakfast and lunch menus.

REMINDERS

- Please send masks, diapers, wipes, and extra clothes for your child according to their individual needs. Make sure all clothing is marked on the tag with your child's initials in a permanent marker to prevent confusion.
- For children in preschool, please send in a blanket and crib sheet every Monday that will be sent home on Fridays for washing. Mark all items with your child's name.
- School starts at 9 am and ends at 2:30 pm (preschool) or 3 pm (elementary school).
- Morning care is available from 7:30 am to 9 am on a limited basis and for a monthly fee of \$130. Please see Stacy or Karen for application and information.
- Aftercare is available from 2:30 pm until 5 pm free of charge courtesy of a grant from the Children's Services Council of Broward County. Application is required, please see Stacy or Karen for additional information. Children enrolled in this program are also eligible for child care on select non-school days (see enclosed calendar).
- All children MUST be picked up by 5 pm. There is a late fee of \$5 per minute for late pick-ups.
- All children must be signed in at the start of the day and have their temperature checked by a staff member, and they must be signed out at the end of the day.
